### **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TRADE**

#### 1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 "Allgo Plumbing" shall mean Allgo Plumbing & Drainage Limited, or any agents or employees thereof.
- 1.2 "Customer" shall mean the Customer, any person acting on behalf of and with the authority of the Customer, or any person purchasing Services and Products from Allgo Plumbing.
- 1.3 "Products" shall mean:
  - 1.3.1 all Products of the general description specified on the front of this agreement and supplied by Allgo Plumbing to the Customer; and
  - 1.3.2 all Products supplied by Allgo Plumbing to the Customer; and
  - 1.3.3 all inventory of the Customer that is supplied by Allgo Plumbing; and
  - 1.3.4 all Products supplied by Allgo Plumbing and further identified in any invoice issued by Allgo Plumbing to the Customer, which invoices are deemed to be incorporated into and form part of this agreement; and
  - 1.3.5 all Products that are marked as having been supplied by Allgo Plumbing or that are stored by the Customer in a manner that enables them to be identified as having been supplied by Allgo Plumbing; and
  - 1.3.6 all of the Customer's present and after-acquired Products that Allgo Plumbing has performed work on or to or in which goods or materials supplied or financed by Allgo Plumbing have been attached or incorporated.
  - 1.3.7 The above descriptions may overlap but each is independent of and does not limit the others.
- 1.4 "Services and Products" shall mean all services, products, goods, and advice provided by Allgo Plumbing to the Customer and shall include without limitation all plumbing and drainlaying services and the supply of associated products and all charges for labour, hire charges, insurance charges, or any fee or charge associated with the supply of Services and Products by Allgo Plumbing to the Customer.
- 1.5 'Price' shall mean the cost of the Services and Products as agreed between Allgo Plumbing and the Customer and includes all disbursements eg charges Allgo Plumbing pay to others on the Customer's behalf subject to clause 4 of this contract.

#### 2. ACCEPTANCE

2.1 Any instructions received by Allgo Plumbing from the Customer for the supply of Services and Products shall constitute a binding contract and acceptance of the terms and conditions contained herein.

### 3. COLLECTION AND USE OF INFORMATION

- 3.1 The Customer authorises Aligo Plumbing to collect, retain and use any information about the Customer, for the purpose of assessing the Customer's credit worthiness, enforcing any rights under this contract, or marketing any Services and Products provided by Aligo Plumbing to any other party.
- 3.2 The Customer authorises Allgo Plumbing to disclose any information obtained to any person for the purposes set out in clause 3.1.
- 3.3 Where the Customer is a natural person the authorities under clauses 3.1 and 3.2 are authorities or consents for the purposes of the Privacy Act 1993.

#### 4. PRICE

- 4.1 Where no price is stated in writing or agreed to orally the Services and Products shall be deemed to be sold at the current amount as such Services and Products are sold by Allgo Plumbing at the time of the contract.
- 4.2 The price may be increased by the amount of any reasonable increase in the cost of supply of the Services and Products that is beyond the control of Allgo Plumbing between the date of the contract and delivery of the Products and Services.

### 5. PAYMENT

- 5.1 Payment for Services and Products shall be made in full on or before the 20th day of the month following the date of the invoice ("the due date"). \* For account holders only
- 5.2 Interest may be charged on any amount owing after the due date at the rate of 2.5% per month or part month.
- 5.3 Any expenses, disbursements and legal costs incurred by Allgo Plumbing in the enforcement of any rights contained in this contract shall be paid by the Customer, including any reasonable solicitor's fees or debt collection agency fees.
- 5.4 Receipt of a chaque, bill of exchange, or other negotiable instrument shall not constitute payment until such negotiable instrument is paid in full.
- 5.5 A deposit may be required.

### 6. QUOTATION

- 6.1 Where a quotation is given by Allgo Plumbing for Services and Products:
  - 6.1.1 Unless otherwise agreed the quotation shall be valid for thirty (30) days from the date of issue; and
  - 6.1.2 The quotation shall be exclusive of goods and services tax unless specifically stated to the contrary;
  - 6.1.3 Allgo Plumbing reserves the right to alter the quotation because of circumstances beyond its control.
- 6.2 Where Services and Products are required in addition to the quotation the Customer agrees to pay for the additional cost of such Services and Products.

## 7. AGENCY

- 7.1 The Customer authorises Allgo Plumbing to contract either as principal or agent for the provision of Services and Products that are the malter of this contract.
- 7.2 Where Allgo Plumbing enters into a contract of the type referred to in clause 7.1 it shall be read with and form part of this agreement and the Customer agrees to pay any amounts due under that contract.

### 8. TITLE AND SECURITY (PERSONAL PROPERTY SECURITIES ACT 1999)

- 8.1 Title in any Services and Products supplied by Allgo Plumbing passes to the Customer only when the Customer has made payment in full for all Services and Products provided by Allgo Plumbing and of all other sums due to Allgo Plumbing by the Customer on any account whatsoever. Until all sums due to Allgo Plumbing by the Customer have been paid in full, Allgo Plumbing has a security interest in all Services and Products.
- 8.2 If the Services and Products are attached, fixed, or Incorporated into any property of the Customer, by way of any manufacturing or assembly process by the Customer or any third party, title in the Services and Products shall remain with Allgo Plumbing until the Customer has made payment for all Services and Products, and where those Services and Products are mixed with other property so as to be part of or a constituent of any new Services and Products, title to these new Services and Products shall deemed to be assigned to Allgo Plumbing as security for the full satisfaction by the Customer of the full amount owing between Allgo Plumbing and Customer. The Customer gives irrevocable authority to Allgo Plumbing to enter any premises occupied by the Customer or on which Services and

Products are situated at any reasonable time after default by the Customer or before default if Allgo Plumbing believes a default is likely and to remove and repossess any Services and Products and any other property to which Services and Products are attached or in which Services and Products are incorporated. Allgo Plumbing shall not be liable for any costs, damages, expenses or losses incurred by the Customer or any third party as a result of this action, nor liable in contract or in tort or otherwise in any way whatsoever unless by statute such liability cannot be excluded. Allgo Plumbing may either resell any repossessed Services and Products and credit the Customer's account with the net proceeds of sale (after deduction of all repossession, storage, selling and other costs) or may retain any repossessed Services and Products and credit the Customer's account with the invoice value thereof less such sum as Allgo Plumbing reasonably determines on account of wear and lear, depreciation, obsolescence, loss or profit and costs.

- 8.3 Where Services and Products are retained by Allgo Plumbing pursuant to clause 8.2 the Customer waives the right to receive notice under s. 120 of the Personal Property Securities Act 1999 (\*PPSA\*) and to object under s.121 of the PPSA.
- 8.4 The following shall constitute defaults by the Customer:
  - 8.4.1 Non payment of any sum by the due date.
  - 8.4.2 The Customer inlimates that it will not pay any sum by the due date.
  - 8.4.3 Any Services and Products are seized by any other creditor of the Customer or any other creditor intimates that it intends to seize Services and Products.
  - 8.4.4 Any Services and Products in the possession of the Customer are materially damaged while any sum due from the Customer to Allgo Plumbing remains unpaid.
  - 8.4.5 The Customer is bankrupted or put into liquidation or a receiver is appointed to any of the Customer's assets or a landlord distains against any of the Customer's assets.
  - 8.4.6 A Court judgment is entered against the Customer and remains unsatisfied for seven (7) days.
  - .4.7 Any material adverse change in the financial position of the Customer.

#### 9. SECURITY INTEREST FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS

9.1 The Customer gives Allgo Plumbing a security interest in all of the Customer's present and after-acquired properly that Allgo Plumbing has performed services on or to or in which Products or materials supplied or financed by Allgo Plumbing have been attached or incorporated.

#### 10. DISPUTES

10.1 No claim relating to Services and Products will be considered unless made within fourteen (14) days of supply or installation.

#### 11. LIABILITY

- 11.1 The Consumer Guarantees Act 1993, the Fair Trading Act 1986 and other statutes may imply warranties or conditions or impose obligations upon Allgo Plumbing which cannot by law (or which can only to a limited extent by law) be excluded or modified. In respect of any such implied warranties, conditions or terms imposed on Allgo Plumbing, Allgo Plumbing's liability shall, where it is allowed, be excluded or if not able to be excluded only apply to the minimum extent required by the relevant statute.
- 11.2 Except as otherwise provided by clause 11.1 Allgo Plumbing shall not be liable for:
  - 11.2.1 Any loss or damage of any kind whatsoever, arising from the supply of Services and Products by Allgo Plumbing to the Customer, including consequential loss whether suffered or incurred by the Customer or another person and whether in contract or tort (including negligence) or otherwise and irrespective of whether such loss or damage arises directly or indirectly from Services and Products provided by Allgo Plumbing to the Customer; and
  - 11.2.2 The Customer shall indemnify Allgo Plumbing against all claims and loss of any kind whatsoever however caused or arising and without limiting the generality of the foregoing of this clause whether caused or arising as a result of the negligence of Allgo Plumbing or otherwise, brought by any person in connection with any matter, act, omission, or error by Allgo Plumbing its agents or employees in connection with the Services and Products.
  - 11.2.3 If contrary to the disclaimer or liability contained in these terms and conditions of trade Aligo Plumbing is deemed liable to the Customer, following and arising from the supply of Services and Products by Aligo Plumbing to the Customer, then such liability is limited in its aggregate to \$500.

# 12. WARRANTY

12.1 Manufacturer's warranty applies where applicable.

### 13. CONSUMER GUARANTEES ACT

13.1 The guarantees contained in the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 are excluded where the Customer acquires Services and Products from Allgo Plumbing for the purposes of a business in terms of section 2 and 43 of that Act.

# 14. PERSONAL GUARANTEE OF COMPANY DIRECTORS OR TRUSTEES

14.1 If the Customer is a company or trust, the director(s) or trustee(s) signing this contract, in consideration for Allgo Plumbing agreeing to supply Services and Products and grant credit to the Customer at their request, also sign this contract in their personal capacity and jointly and severally personally undertake as principal debtors to Allgo Plumbing the payment of any and all monies now or hereafter owed by the Customer to Allgo Plumbing and Indemnify Allgo Plumbing against non-payment by the Customer. Any personal liability of a signatory hereto shall not exclude the Customer in any way whatsoever from the liabilities and obligations contained in this contract. The signatories and Customer shall be jointly and severally liable under the terms and conditions of this contract and for payment of all sums due hereunder.

# 15. MISCELLANEOUS

- 15.1 Allgo Plumbing shall not be liable for delay or failure to perform its obligations if the cause of the delay or failure is beyond its control.
- 15.2 Failure by Allgo Plumbing to enforce any of the terms and conditions contained in this contract shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any of the rights or obligations Allgo Plumbing has under this contract.
- 15.3 If any provision of this contract shall be invalid, void or illegal or unenforceable the validity existence, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected, prejudiced or impaired.
- 15.4 Where applicable the Construction Contracts Act 2002 applies.
- 15.5 If the Customer defaults in payment then the Customer agrees that where the Services and Products relate to Customers land, then the amount of such default gives rise to a legal or equitable estate or interest in the Customer's land which entitles Allgo Plumbing to enter a caveal against the Customer's land pursuant to the Land Transfer Act 1952 and its amendments or any legislation in substitution thereof.
